Admission Policy

Since its inception, VU has set a benchmark in higher technical education across the country. The university provides a platform for students from numerous Indian states and even abroad. VU has consistently fostered a culture of diversity, tolerance, and acceptance.

With an alumni base of over 50,000 individuals contributing to various organizations in India and abroad, VU offers an opportunity to learn from experts and thrive in professional life.

Admission Procedure

Indian Candidates

- Notifications and advertisements about the application forms and important dates will be published on the VU website.
- Application forms can be filled out online on the VU official website by paying the non-refundable fee of ₹ 1,000/- for the entrance examination and admission processing. This payment can be made through the online mode (Net Banking/Card/G-Pay, etc.)
- Admissions will be purely based on the Ranks/Percentile/Scores secured in the All-India National Level Entrance Tests/ UPPSEE CET/ VU CET conducted by university through online and offline mode which would be consistent with the Computer Based Test (CBT) & Personal Interaction (PI)/ Media Report/ SoP/ Drawing Test/ Portfolio (as applicable) and based on suitable eligibility criteria program-wise.
- The Results of the selection will be published on the individual applicant dashboard or informed via mail and over telephone.
- Eligible candidates will be allocated programmes based on their ranks/ Percentile/ Scores in the respective entrance examinations, and/or qualifying examinations as per eligibility & the merit cut-offs defined for the relevant selection process.

International Candidates

- Admissions will be based on marks or grades obtained in the qualifying examinations as per eligibility criteria, and availability of seat(s).
- The admissions process is based on a first-come, first-served basis by equivalence committee.
- Equivalence committee will be headed by registrar, Vidya University and this committee shall be responsible to check and verify all the documents before provisional admissions.

Application Submission - Online

- The application shall be submitted via the website. Link: Vidya website.
- Candidates should fill out their personal information and contact details (email address & phone number) properly, as all the important updates will be communicated to registered email ID & phone number only.
- The important instructions regarding entrance test, personal interaction, and selection process will be communicated from time to time and the candidate should check the details on VU official website and on their registered email ID.

Important instructions for filling the online application form

- **Personal Profile:** The name of the candidate and his/her parents must be the same as mentioned on their class 10th std. marksheet/certificate (No prefix should be used).
- **Registered contact details:** Please ensure the contact details mentioned in the application form are accurate.
- **Academic Profile:** The candidate should enter the marks obtained in qualifying examinations (10th, 12th, Bachelor's Degree marks etc). If the qualifying examinations result is not declared, then the candidate should enter the marks within 5 days from the date of declaration of results. The score of National level Entrance Test(s)/ UPPSEE CET (as applicable) should be updated in the application form within 5 days from the date of declaration of results. The candidate should upload the score card(s) of respective entrance examination and qualifying examination marksheet(s) accordingly. Applications with incomplete and without qualifying marks/ entrance score/ marks will not be considered for further selection process.
- **SOP (Statement of Purpose):** The SoP should be submitted through online mode in the application form (wherever applicable). A SoP, also known as a letter of intent/ video, is written statement addressed to the admission panel and can be talks about your career path, interests, professional contributions, goals, and the driving force behind pursuing a particular Pedagogy/ Programme.
- **Upload Documents:** We prefer required documents downloaded through DigiLocker or self-attested scanned and readable copies in the application form. The documents downloaded through DigiLocker/ Readable self-attested scanned documents to be kept handy while submitting the application form.
- **Payment** of application fees for the entrance examination ₹ 1800/- through online mode (Net banking/Card/G-pay, etc.) which will be non-refundable in any circumstance.
- **Latest Photograph:** The candidate must upload the latest passport size photograph, as this will be used for further official record(s) like student ID card etc.

- Allocation of seats is based on merit in the National Entrance Examination/ UPPSEE CET/ VU CET etc.
- The Programmes for which CET is not applicable, the allocation of seats is based on board/ degree examinations score.
- VU will not be responsible if any candidate misses to attending the entrance/ admission round/ the counselling round on the respective dates allotted.
- There won't be any change in the date of the entrance/ admission round/ the counselling round for the candidate.
- Candidates will be allocated seats based on merit, and vacancies.

The Result Status will be communicated as follows: -

- **SELECTED:** The candidate has been selected based on the selection/merit criteria and must proceed with the further admission process, including fee payment, self-registration, eligibility verification, and submission of original documents as required.
- **WAITING:** The candidate is on the waiting list and may have to wait for the updated status of the merit list.
- **HOLD:** The candidate's application is on hold due to incomplete information or requirements, such as unsubmitted entrance examination scores, educational marks, or mandatory tests. These candidates may update the necessary details and await the next merit list declaration. OR The applicant is on hold for consideration in next/ upcoming round(s) and subject to availability of vacant seat(s).
- **REJECTED:** The candidate has not met the selection criteria for the specified course/programme and is therefore not selected.

Eligibility

Indian National Candidate

- **UG Programmes:** The candidate must have passed the 10th (SSC), 12th (HSC) from state boards/ CBSE/ ICSE/ IGCSE(ICE), IB-Diploma & any other recognised board by the competent authority. All International Baccalaureate (IB) students are required to have a minimum 24 credit points with awarded IB-Diploma. An equivalence/ conversion certificate is required from the respective board/ AIU in case the result is in grade/credit points.
- **PG Programmes:** The candidate must have a Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent degree from any recognized University approved by the UGC/AIU.

Eligibility criteria for different courses will be as per the notification of UGC India and other competent Governing Authorities

University Transfers

VU Offers admissions to various second-year Undergraduate Programmes across various streams. It can be a great opportunity for aspirants who wish to take admission at VU by transferring from another University at the end of their first year to VU.

- The candidates will be offered programme based on the availability of vacant seats.
- Candidates can fill out the University Transfer form available on the online application portal of VU. The paid application fee is non-refundable.
- If the number of applications received is more than the vacant seats in the program/course, the admission offers will be based on merit for the particular programme for Second Year Admissions.
- The application can be considered for Second Year admission at VU based on the equivalence of the subjects as well as the syllabus that the candidate has studied during the First Year and the subjects and syllabus of VU for the First Year.
- The VU equivalence committee's decision will be final for offering the Second-Year University Transfer Admission. If the candidate has not attached the Result for First Year, and an attested copy of the syllabus of the previous university, the application will not be considered for further admission process.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Meerut, UP only.

Important instructions for University Transfer admissions:

The candidate must submit the following documents to the VU within 10 days from the date of confirmation of admission.

1. The Original Leaving or Transfer Certificate issued by the previous Institution /University.
2. A Migration Certificate issued by your previous University.
3. Attested copy of First Year result (basic eligibility is passed with no backlog in the examinations).
4. A copy of the Aadhar card and Permanent address proof.

International Candidate

- **Under-Graduate (UG) Programmes:** The candidate must have passed the Std. 10+2 or its equivalent examinations from the recognized institution approved by the Government.
- **Post-Graduate (PG) Programmes:** The candidate must have a Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent Degree from any recognized University approved by Government (AIU).

VU follows UGC-specified eligibility norms while reviewing international students' admission applications. To take admission for any programme at VU under international category, the admission categories of international candidates are as mentioned below:

A. Foreign Nationals Students: A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she is a citizen of any country other than India and holds a foreign passport (FN - SAARC countries: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and FN-Non-SAARC Countries).

B. CIWGC/CIWSEA Students: Children of Indians working in Gulf Countries & Southeast Asian countries, (the candidates whose parents are working at Gulf countries or Southeast Asian countries) only are eligible under this category.

C. OCI Students: A student is eligible to apply as OCI if he/she has been granted Overseas Citizenship of India and has an OCI card.

D. NRI: A student is eligible for NRI Category if he/she is a Non-Resident Indian (Other than Gulf & Southeast Asia Countries). VU Offers attractive scholarships to all our International Category students (Refer Annexure 2).

In addition, One Foreign National category student per Programme is awarded with 100% scholarship, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Note: Admission Eligibility Criteria, and fee structure are specific to each programme. Kindly check the respective programme pages of our official website.

Additional Documents required for International/NRI/Foreign candidates:

- Student & Parent Passport Copy (Passport copy submission is mandatory).
- Original Employer Certificate (If applicable).
- Original Sponsorship Letter (If applicable). NRI certificate (Applicable for NRI category students).

Important Note:

- For detailed programme wise eligibility criteria, please refer Annexure 1 mentioned below and/or refer VU official website for programme wise eligibility. • VU retains the right to make changes to any published schedule.
- The eligibility criteria defined and declared by the appropriate authority, university from time to time will apply to all applicants.
- Applicants must carefully review the eligibility criteria for their chosen programme(s) before completing the application form.
- The University reserves the right to disqualify any candidate at any stage of the admissions process if they are found ineligible or have provided false or incorrect information. In such cases, the candidate's provisional admission will be cancelled.

Reservations

The reservation seats in the admissions for the students belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), De-notified Tribes (DT), Vimukta Jatis (VJ), Nomadic Tribes (NT), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Special Backward Category (SBC) and students with disabilities shall be allocated as per the policy of the Uttar Pradesh State Government. VU reserves the rights accordingly.

Out of the total approved intake capacity, at least forty percent of the seats shall be reserved for the students having domicile in the State of Uttar Pradesh.
